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**The Christian and the Law – Part 8:  
Freedom from the Condemning Mosaic Law  
Galatian 3:1-29**

**Big Idea: As Christians in the New Covenant, we are entirely free from the condemning Mosaic Old Covenant law**

Paul's main concern in Galatians—A false Jewish gospel  
(Galatians 1:6-8; 2:4; 5:1-6)

**I. The Mosaic law cannot save, only faith in the gospel can.**

A. We are justified by faith alone, not works. (Genesis 15:6)

B. The Mosaic Covenant cannot supercede the Abrahamic Covenant of Promise. (Acts 7:53; Hebrews 2:2)



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## II. The Mosaic law was only a temporary tool for condemnation.

A. The Law required perfection for life—A Covenant of Works  
(Habakkuk 2:4; Deuteronomy 27:26; Leviticus 18:5; Genesis 2:16-17;  
Romans 2:12)

*God gave Adam a law of comprehensive obedience written in his heart and a specific precept not to eat the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. By these God obligated him and all his descendants to personal, total, exact and perpetual obedience. God promised life if Adam fulfilled it and threatened death if he broke it, and He gave Adam the power and ability to keep it. ~1689 London Confession 19.1*

B. The Law condemned men as hopelessly sinful and drove us to Christ. (Romans 5:20; 7:5; Galatians 4:1-5)

*To run and work the law commands,  
Yet gives me neither feet nor hands  
But better news the gospel brings:  
It bids me fly and gives me wings ~John Bunyan*

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
